<b>Case Management:</b> Assess the needs of an older individual; develop a service plan to meet the needs of the individual and monitor the delivery of services.	
<b>Congregate Meals:</b> A nutritionally balanced meal provided in a group setting.	
<b>Elder Rights:</b> Elder abuse assessment & intervention- service to assist an individual at risk of or experiencing abuse, neglect, or financial exploitation.	
<b>Family Caregiver Counseling:</b> Provide counseling to caregivers to assist them in making decisions and solving problems relating to their caregiver roles.	
<b>Health Promotion/Evidence-Based:</b> Monthly educational materials, presentations, and activities promoting better health and wellness.	
<b>Home Delivered Meals (Nutrition):</b> Nutritionally balanced meal delivered to the residence of homebound individuals.	
<b>Information &amp; Assistance:</b> Provide an individual with current information on services available within a community.	
<b>Legal Assistance:</b> Legal advice and representation provided by an attorney to older individuals with economic or social needs.	
<b>Options Counseling:</b> An interactive process where individuals receive information to make informed choices about long-term supports.	
<b>Nutrition Counseling:</b> Provides individualized guidance to individuals who are at nutritional risk.	
<b>Nutrition Education:</b> A targeted program provided monthly to all congregate and home-delivered meal participants to promote better health by providing accurate and culturally sensitive nutrition, physical fitness, or health as it relates to nutrition information.

<b>Adult Day Care:</b> Service provided to adults who require care and supervision in a protective setting for a portion of a 24-hour day.	
<b>Assisted Transportation:</b> Provides or arranges for the travel, including travel costs for the individual from one location to another. Could also include assistance in and out of the vehicle.	
<b>Behavioral Health Support:</b> Mental health outreach services to an older individual within the community.	
<b>Chore:</b> Performance of heavy household tasks provided in a person's home and or yard.	
<b>Emergency Response System:</b> A service provided to a consumer that includes the installation of and monthly fee for an emergency response system.	
<b>Home Maker:</b> Performance of light housekeeping tasks provided in a person's home and assistance with errands.	
<b>Material Aid:</b> Provides services or goods to promote safety at home.	
<b>Outreach:</b> Provision of one on one interventions initiated by an agency or organization to identify potential consumers and encourage their use of existing services and benefits.	
<b>Personal Care:</b> Assistance with Activities of Daily Living/and or health-related tasks.	
<b>Family Care Giver Respite Care:</b> Service which offers temporary, substitute supports or living arrangement for care recipients to provide a brief period of relief or rest for caregivers	
<b>Family Caregiver Support Groups:</b> A service to facilitate caregivers to discuss their common concerns related to caregiving and provide mutual support to each other.	
<b>Training and Education:</b> Activities meant to impart knowledge, experience, or skills to an individual or group regarding AAA services.	
<b>Transportation:</b> Services or activities that provide or arrange for travel, including travel costs, for individuals from one location to another. Does not include any other activity.
